The Youth Bureau has groups for youth in grades 6-12. The Heights Heroes offers Elmira Heights youth in grades 6-8 a way to get involved and the Horseheads Action Team does the same with Horseheads Youth in grades 7th and 8th. The Town of Horseheads Youth Council group provides youth grades 9-12 an opportunity to get involved with the community! All three groups offer youth the opportunity to better themselves and serve their community through community service projects! The Action Team and the Heights Heroes are continuously growing with an active member base of 20-30; Youth Council is a group of 45 members strong that knows how to have a great time! Make sure you keep your eyes open in the community to see what the Youth Bureau's youth driven groups are doing in our community! The Town of Horseheads Youth Court, a nationally recognized delinquency prevention program, provides its members and offenders many opportunities. Members have the opportunity to serve their community. Offenders gain the opportunity to learn about the justice system while not being sent to Family Court, not being labeled as a juvenile delinquent and not having to pay for costly attorney fees. The Horseheads Youth Court is starting a new training session for prospective members in October; if you are interested, make sure you get your registration form in!

If you are in need of some yard work or snow shoveling this season, make sure you check out the Youth Employment Service! A quick simple call to the Youth Bureau will have a youth at your door A.S.A.P. The Youth Employment Service is a win-win situation; it provides labor to those in need and an opportunity for youth to make a little extra money! Youth can also earn money with our Youth Enterprise Opportunity!

If you are looking to learn a new skill, attend some workshops provided by the Learning Web! Learning Web provides the opportunity for youth to learn new skills, such as babysitting, cooking and much more! Learning Web also provides the opportunity for people to share their special skills and knowledge.
