The second monthly meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Horseheads was held at the above date at the Town Hall, 150 Wygant Road, Horseheads, NY 14845.

At 8:00 A.M. Supervisor Fischer called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

At this portion of the meeting, Supervisor Fischer wanted to discuss a recent letter from the County of Chemung Law Department regarding sales tax proceeds and the allocation rates and reductions over the next year. This was given to the local municipalities to encourage them to plan their future budgets for this decrease.

Next, Supervisor Fischer wanted to discuss and request from Marty Vanderhoff, Highway Superintendent.

Marty would like to purchase an FCar Scanner which will do the diagnostic readings on the Town Trucks. This would save the \$45-\$50 per hour the Town is being charged every time a truck would need this done prior to work being done on them. This total cost is \$4,495.00 and would be split and shared with the Town of Veteran. The ruling is that all Veteran trucks would come to the Town and all scanning will be done at the Town of Horseheads.

At this point in the meeting Supervisor Fischer wanted to congratulate Nancy Rohde on her recertification as a Registered Municipal Clerk. He wanted the Board to recognize all of the hard work and dedication that goes in to the job, and wanted to present her with her certificate.

As there was no further business to come before the board, a motion as made by Mr. Wilber, and seconded by Mr. Riopko to adjourn at 9:09 A.M.
